Words Their Way with English Learners Pearson

The focus of the study was to determine if using the Words Their Way (Bear, Invernizzi, Templeton, and Johnston, 2008) word study approach would improve the orthographic knowledge of third- and fourth-grade students at Weber Elementary in Iowa City, Iowa during the fall of 2010. The program assessed the student's current spelling stage with the Elementary Spelling Inventory and individualized the spelling instruction to meet their needs.

Students spent 15 minutes daily learning common spelling patterns, along with the exceptions, and sorted words under the matching phonemic pattern. The study used a pretest/posttest design over a nine-week period. During the study, data were collected weekly and students tracked their growth on individual graphs. Posttest results on the Elementary Spelling Inventory showed an overall increase in orthographic knowledge.
