Le parole vengono scritte nelle caselle bianche sia in senso orizzontale (da sinistra a destra), sia in senso verticale (dall'alto in basso), partendo dalle caselle numerate che si trovano sui bordi e negli angoli creati dalle caselle nere. Le parole inserite, che vengono suggerite da apposite definizioni, devono rispettare gli incroci che si vengono reciprocamente a creare nello schema tra parole orizzontali e parole verticali. Esistono anche qui numerose varianti, tra cui quella "a sbarramenti misti" (caselle nere e ingrossamenti del bordo).
