Include pictures of your samples in on your fliers and brochures. 10. Ask your friends and family members to tell others about your business. Many of their friends and coworkers may be interested in unique gifts. 11. Visit local boutiques and consignment shops to show your jewelry to the owners. They may agree to display your jewelry in exchange for a percentage of the money from each sale. 12. Display your jewelry designs at craft fairs, church bazaars and flea markets.
