discussed. Students may download all sample programs with the provided link. YouTube video links were also provided if one opts to learn the topics through video presentations. Object-oriented programming(OOP) is not yet discussed on this book. Though java is an OOP language, the author believes OOP concepts are too broad or too early to discuss for students who are just starting to learn programming.
