connection to the secretive Haven
research facility. Hungry for answers, she
travels to Florida, only to stumble upon
two replicas and a completely new set of
questions. While the stories of Lyra and
Gemma mirror each other, each contains
breathtaking revelations critically
important to the other story. Using

book, as with the print version. They can
