The *Missa Festiva* was not written until 1937. This is the choral score of the work, with Latin text, and without notated accompaniment.

Theory b.i.t. online Verlag Was Franco sympathetic to Nazi Germany? Why didn't Spain enter World War II? In what ways did Spain collaborate with the Third Reich? How much did Spain assist Jewish refugees? This is the first book in any language to answer these intriguing questions. Franco's only personal meeting with Hitler, in 1940

to discuss precisely this, is recounted here in groundbreaking detail that also sheds significant new light on the Spanish government's vacillating policy toward Jewish refugees, on the Holocaust, and on Spain's German connection throughout the duration of the war.
