In today's culture wars, both liberals and their conservative enemies, inside and outside the academy, rest their claims about the present on the notion that the Enlightenment was a secularist movement of philosophically driven emancipation. Historians

have had doubts about the accuracy of this portrait for some time, but they have never managed to furnish a viable alternative to it—for themselves, for scholars interested in matters of church and state, or for the public at large. In this book, William J. Bulman and Robert G. The commission and the report were implemented after Congress passed an act in 2009 to review and

prevent fraudulent activity. The report details, among other things, the periods before, during, and after the crisis, what led up to it, and analyses of subprime mortgage lending, credit expansion and banking policies, the collapse of companies like Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac, and the federal bailouts of Lehman and AIG. The commission consisted of private citizens with expertise in economics and finance, banking, housing, market regulation, and consumer protection. They examined and reported on "the collapse of major financial institutions that
