Anti-vaxxers have changed their minds, but rarely because someone has given them a list of facts. Berman argues that antivaccination activism is tied closely to how people see themselves as parents and community members. Effective pro-vaccination efforts should emphasize these cultural aspects rather than battling social media posts.
