lady's escort  
played an  
essential part  
in promoting a  
couple's social  
life. Indeed,  
the company  
and friendship  
(and perhaps  
love) which  
bound a lady  
and her escort  
occurred with  
the knowledge  
and under the  
control of the  
families of the  
interested  
parties. Of  
course, this  
'triangular'  
arrangement  
was not  
unproblematic  
. The  
existence of a  
third party  
posed a threat

to conjugal fidelity and the legitimacy of offspring and, towards the early nineteenth century, when the ideals of Romanticism and the French Revolution were popular there was a rapid decline in the practice. constituted an intolerable blemish. This book explores the role of Mediterranean imaginaries in one of the preeminent tropes of Italian history: the formation or 'making of' Italians.
