 even more aggressive strategy for undermining US hegemony,
 adopting the phrase "great changes unseen in century." After
 charting how China's long game has evolved, Doshi offers a
 comprehensive yet asymmetric plan for an effective US response.
 Ironically, his proposed approach takes a page from Beijing's own
 strategic playbook to undermine China's ambitions and
 strengthen American order without competing dollar-for-dollar,
 ship-for-ship, or loan-for-loan.

mixed legacy: it promoted the reform of the education system, popular participation in local self-government, and administrative rationalization. But it also resulted in exaggerated fears of political dissent, reinforcing the authority of the monarchical state and inhibiting the formation of a vibrant system of parliamentary rule.
