Il volume corredda un breve percorso espositivo a pannelli (testi e immagini) per presentare i risultati delle ricerche e degli scavi svolti dal 2011 ad oggi nel sito archeologico 'Antiche Mura' di Jesolo. 'In limine' è una poesia di Eugenio Montale (introduce la raccolta "Ossi di Seppia"). Il titolo, e la poesia stessa, sono sembrati pertinenti a sintetizzare il senso del progetto archeologico sull'antica Equilo, di cui si pubblicano in questo volume i primi risultati. 'In limine' significa 'sulla soglia': indica cioè un punto di passaggio, un confine; e, nel nostro caso, metaforicamente rimarca il discrimine tra passato e presente, il luogo archeologico dove la materia inerte diviene narrazione. Qui, in limine, è anche uno spazio fisico preciso, quello dell'area delle 'Antiche Mura', luogo anche tangibile della memoria collettiva. Un luogo, ieri come oggi, ai margini. Se l'antica Equilo era stato un insediamento sul confine instabile tra mare e laguna, la moderna Jesolo, che ne ha ereditato il nome, ha lasciato che i ruderi della sua memoria restassero al di fuori del centro abitato: nel punto dove la città diventa campagna, lì sorgono le rovine dell'antica cattedrale, lì rimane il reliquiario della comunità, come una sorta di giardino 'dove affonda un morto viluppo di memorie' (di nuovo Montale). Gli archeologi hanno cercato nel tempo di recuperare quelle memorie e quel passato, con pazienza e fatica. Così, il progetto nato qualche anno fa per iniziativa del Dipartimento di Studi Umanistici dell'Università Ca' Foscari di Venezia, non costituisce che l'ultimo atto di un percorso che ha inizio dalla metà del secolo scorso, con gli scavi nell'area della cattedrale e nel vicino sito della chiesa di San Mauro. I contributi che si pubblicano in questa circostanza raccontano e sintetizzano i risultati degli ultimi anni di scavi. L'interconnessione tra le varie strategie di indagine ci ha consentito di proporre una ricostruzione storico-insediativa del sito del tutto inedita e sorprendente.

Dal 2001 Nonantola è al centro di un importante progetto di ricerca archeologica che ha consentito di acquisire molte informazioni su una delle più importanti strutture insediative del Medioevo italiano: il monastero di San Silvestro, il suo borgo e il territorio circostante. Il quinto volume relativo a questo progetto riguarda i risultati degli scavi eseguiti in una delle piazze centrali del centro storico di Nonantola: Piazza Liberazione. Questo luogo era già stato oggetto nel 2004 di limitati sondaggi archeologici da cui era emersa una porzione della chiesa di San Lorenzo e del cimitero di pertinenza. Nell'estate del 2015 l'Amministrazione Comunale, all'interno di un progetto di riqualificazione urbana cofinanziato dalla Regione Emilia-

Romagna che ha interessato il centro storico di Nonantola, ha avviato i lavori di rifacimento della piazza. Tale intervento ha consentito all'Università Ca' Foscari di Venezia, sotto la direzione scientifica del Prof. Sauro Gelichi, in co-direzione con la Soprintendenza Archeologia, belle arti e paesaggio per la città metropolitana di Bologna e le province di Modena, Reggio Emilia e Ferrara, di effettuare un'indagine complessiva con l'esplorazione di estese aree di scavo. È stato così possibile scrivere un'altra inedita pagina della storia di questo luogo, che acquista ancora più significato e valore se messa in rapporto con quella del grande cenobio. Sono state portate alla luce le fondazioni della chiesa di San Lorenzo, di cui sono state documentate due fasi costruttive (XI-XII secolo e XII-XIV secolo) con le sepolture dell'area cimiteriale circostante. Andando oltre i confini dell'edificio di culto - e scendendo in profondità - sono emerse tracce dell'insediamento più antico, anteriore anche alla fondazione di San Lorenzo. Infatti le fasi più antiche riferibili all'abitato di IX-X secolo sono attestate da strutture in legno con funzione abitativa ed artigianale nel settore orientale, mentre l'area occidentale era interessata da strutture in legno collegate ad un fossato difensivo, ipotetiche tracce delle prime difese del castrum medievale. In seguito alla defunzionalizzazione della chiesa di San Lorenzo, alla fine del Medioevo, tutta l'area esplorata fu destinata a piazza di mercato con una pavimentazione in laterizi e ciottoli e pilastri in laterizi per l'alloggiamento di tettoie in legno. Il volume raccoglie i dati relativi alla sequenza di scavo, corredata dai risultati derivati dall'analisi delle varie tipologie di reperti archeologici raccolti e pertinenti ai diversi periodi cronologici attestati

Southwest Asia is at the epicenter of zooarchaeological research on pivotal changes in human history such as animal domestication and the emergence of social complexity. This volume continues the long tradition of the ASWA conference series in publishing new research results in the zooarchaeology of southwest Asia and adjacent areas. The book is organized in three thematic areas. The first presents new methodological tools and approaches in the study of animal remains exemplified through studies on domestication, butchery practices, microdebris, intrasite contextual comparisons and age-at-death recording. Besides offering interesting insights into our past, these methodological developments enable higher resolution for future research. The second section focuses on the subsistence economies of prehistoric and early complex societies and provides new insights into how animal management developed in southwest Asia.
