Within DLA Troop Support, the Clothing and Textile (C & T) Directorate supplies more than 8,000 different items ranging from uniforms to footwear and equipment. According to DLA Troop Support's website, sales surpassed \$14.5 billion in Fiscal Year (FY) 2011. Legislative
