The nurses will record the daily inputs and outputs of fluid from a patient. In a nil by mouth (NBM) patient this is particularly important as all fluids must be given IV. Below is an example of a daily fluid balance chart showing some of the possible fluid inputs and outputs that may be recorded (click the image to enlarge). The nurses cannot record insensible losses, however bear in mind a 'healthy' patient will lose approximately 800-1000ml (See Physiology : Fluid ... When a patient is transferred verbal and written documentation must include fluid balance and any concerns. Medical staff documentation must include a clear fluid balance management plan. These measurements are important to help evaluate a person's fluid and electrolyte balance, to suggest various diagnosis, and allows for prompt intervention to correct the imbalance. Records of all intake and output must be kept meticulously in an Intake and Output Chart (I/O Chart).
