The principal investigator for the research effort was Lawrence Suskind of the Department of Urban Studies and Planning. We observed missed opportunities for settlement, negotiating tactics that backfired, and strategies that appeared to be grounded more in intuition than in thoughtful analysis. People negotiated not out of some idealistic commitment to consensus but because they thought it better served their own interests. When some negotiations reached an impasse, people improvised mediation. These disputants succeeded in spite of legal and institutional barriers, even though few of them had a sophisticated understanding of negotiation.
