Sé que me golpea, me maltrata, pero si él me abandona, prefiero morirme, no sé vivir sin su amor". Estas palabras de

una consultante de 35 años, me llevaron como mujer, psicóloga, terapeuta de pareja, a buscar razones y explicaciones de por qué alguien podía desear morirse antes de cerrar una relación, a todas luces, tóxica.

Inicialmente pensé que era sencillo encontrar las causas, quizás en una baja autoestima, en el miedo a la soledad, o quizás en algo un poco más evidente, tener validado el maltrato en la familia de origen, o, tal vez, algunas razones de índole

económico, o de aprendizajes en relaciones anteriores. Ver tanto sufrimiento silenciado, tantas personas acorraladas en relaciones desastrosas, sin salida, envejeciéndonos e, sin más remedio que la resignación, el silencio, la tristeza y el abandono afectivo, esperando que el tiempo pase y que quizás algo externo suceda para poder salir de esa cárcel llamada “amor”, me

dio las fuerzas para develar el paso a paso de estas relaciones tóxicas, que pueden terminar en psicopatías y esclavitudes emocionales. Pero, quizás, el mayor reto fue evidenciar los posibles desenlaces finales de estos males de amor: feminicidios, homicidios o suicidios; tal como lo veremos en los testimonios que acompañan el texto. La esperanza es que podamos construir

relaciones sanas, vínculos de pareja en plenitud. Tenemos la certeza de que esta apuesta es posible. No te la pierdas. *Rosaura a las diez* Ediciones EIM Versos tomados de canciones chilenas inspiran, presentan e impulsan varios pasajes de este libro, compuesto por textos que demuestran que incluso miradas de especialidad y origen distantes entre sí

pueden tener una convincente referencia común a un flujo de poesía cantada y a reflexiones con buen ritmo, esencial a nuestra cultura popular. Ese cruce entre pensamiento y canción, entre la elaboración propia y la síntesis ajena, no es el único estímulo en la lectura, pero de todos modos resulta elocuente del desprejuicio y fuerza que guía al libro completo. Hay hondura y hay provocación en los

permisos que cada autor se da para dejar ideas nuevas de consulta, con una viva invitación a textos por venir.

Azul... (1888) is a book of stories and poems by Rubén Darío. Written while the poet was living in Chile, Azul... has been recognized as a pioneering work of Hispanic Modernism that launched the career of a leading Latin American poet. Both experimental and traditional, Azul... blends Darío's concern over the sustainability

of modern life with his abiding interest in the myths and magic of ancient cultures. Infused with classical symbolism, inspired by the myth and philosophy of Ancient Greece, Rubén Darío's *Azul...* bridges the gap between ancient and modern. Rather than focus on the differences between the two, he envisions the past as a living entity, allowing history and fantasy to

coincide with the social realities of his time. In these poems and stories, fairies from the plays of Shakespeare appear alongside the working men and women of Latin America. *Dreams* coincide with a reality mired in poverty, labor, and passionless social climbing. Poets and port workers sing and die in a city of ghostly beauty. *Azul...* is less a book than it is an experience, and nearly a century and a

half after its publication it remains one worth the taking. With a beautifully designed cover and professionally typeset manuscript, this edition of Rubén Darío's *Azul...* is a classic of Nicaraguan literature reimaged for modern readers.
